Reflections is the National PTA's arts in education program. Its purpose is to provide all children and youth with an opportunity to experience the self fulfillment of creative expression through the arts. ACE PTA is enthusiastically supporting Reflections this year, and Reflections is celebrating its 40th anniversary. (*Students do not have to attend the PTA afterschool workshop to enter their work – work can be turned in to Ms. Taylor, Art Dept by Friday, October 23rd.*)

ACE's PTA Reflections program is hosting, for the first time, an after school workshop. It will be a free opportunity for students to use art materials to create a personal master piece for this year's Reflections Program theme, "Beauty is..." Our PTA Reflection program will be providing paper, crayons, and other materials for your child to use.

Students can enter in more than one category. All students who enter will be recognized by the ACE PTA. Winners will be announced on the morning show. ACE will award prizes for 1st, 2nd and Honorable Mention. 1st place winners will move on to the 16th District PTA contest. The age divisions are Primary K-2, Intermediate 3-5, and Special Needs. Special Needs division is in Kentucky only. Parents of special needs children are able to enter work in any age division that they feel is the most appropriate.

Also, the National PTA is looking for a new theme for the 2011-2012 Reflections Program. Entry forms will be on the ACE website – enter your idea for 2011-2012 as many times as you like.

What to bring:	A small snack for my child
Who can participate:	The first 96 ACE Non-ESP students to register. ESP students are participating; no need to register if in ESP.
What to do:	Complete permission form and send back to school in an envelope marked, ACE PTA/Reflection.
RSVP DUE:	Friday, September 18th

Please pick-up non-ESP students at rear of building in the bus lanes at 4:00 pm. Children will only be released to the person listed on the permission slip. Transportation MUST be arranged by parent, and will not be provided by the school. ESP students will be following normal dismissal.
