1930's – A Special nutrition project and emergency services prevent children from suffering the Great Depression; PTA studies automobile and school bus safety as they relate to children.

1980's – PTA fights for automobile safety belt and child restraint legislation; creates a drug/alcohol abuse prevention project; focuses more attention on children and families in the inner cities; and creates national HIV/AIDS education program for parents.
